



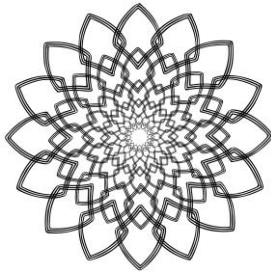

**eHeritage - Expanding the Research and
Innovation Capacity in Cultural Heritage
Virtual Reality Applications**

eHERITAGE Kick Off Meeting took place in Brasov, Romania at University Transilvania of Brasov facilities between 24th -26th of November, 2015

The project eHERITAGE - Expanding the Research and Innovation Capacity in Cultural Heritage Virtual Reality Applications, started successfully with a Kick-Off meeting, co-funded by the EU under the H2020 program, which took place on 24th and 26th of November at the University Transilvania of Brasov in Brasov/Romania. The coordinating institution teamed up with 2 research centers which present themselves as top expert entities in the field of cultural heritage: the Jožef Stefan Institute (Slovenia) and the Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna (Italy).

16 attendees from the 3 partners consortium met together to discuss and agree on main problems and solutions of the project, by detailing the project work plan. All future activities were analyzed, and all foreseeable results were addressed, even the ones from the first weeks of the project's lifetime. This was a key event in the lifecycle of eHERITAGE, as it greatly contributed to the launch of the joint work of the partnership.
