



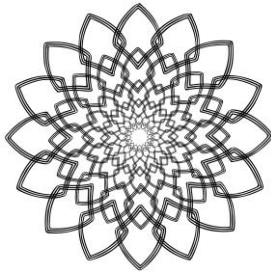

**eHeritage - Expanding the Research and

Virtual Reality Applications**

eHERITAGE's First Exploratory Meeting took place in Pisa, Italy at PERCRO laboratories on the 13th of January, 2016

After the successful KoM, 2016 started in force with the First Exploratory Meeting of the project eHERITAGE - Expanding the Research and Innovation Capacity in Cultural Heritage Virtual Reality Applications. Exploratory meetings are held at the beginning of each project year. The outcome of every exploratory visit resides in the evaluation of potential opportunities for common activities, the identification of open short-term positions linked to the necessary short-staff exchanges, the determination of future scientific events which are worth participating to (also based on the yearly publication plan), and last but not least, the participation to possible funding initiatives or integration projects (with other EU networks of excellence). This event took place on the 13th of January, 2016, and was hosted by the Scuola Superiore Sant'Anna (Italy).

The 14 participants were able to identify viable means of knowledge transfer and joint research opportunities, not to mention the large array of opportunities concerning short-term staff exchanges. The participants also had time to discuss the deliverables which were submitted to the EU, the ethic requirements, the upcoming deliverables from WP 5 (D5.2 Project handbook, D5.3 Quality assurance plan, D5.4 Ethics assurance plan and D5.5 Security assurance plan) and the communication strategy for the following period of time.
