



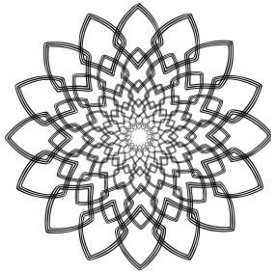

eHERITAGE staff trains in the 5-th Edition of CREATIVE Summer School in Virtual Environments

During 29th of August – 7th of September, 4 members of the UTBV personnel participated in a series of workshops organized under the 5-th Edition of CREATIVE Summer School in Virtual Environments, held at Ovidius University of Constanta by CeRVA Lab of the Faculty of Mathematics and Computer Science in a partnership with National History and Archaeology Museum of Constanta and Transilvania University from Brasov.

CREATIVE 2016 focused on applying mixed reality in the reconstruction of archaeological artefacts discovered in Dobrogea enhanced with animated elements. The project's aim is to specialize students in 3D modelling and historical reconstruction, while having the purpose of adding soft skills such as team work.
