

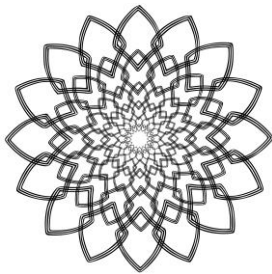

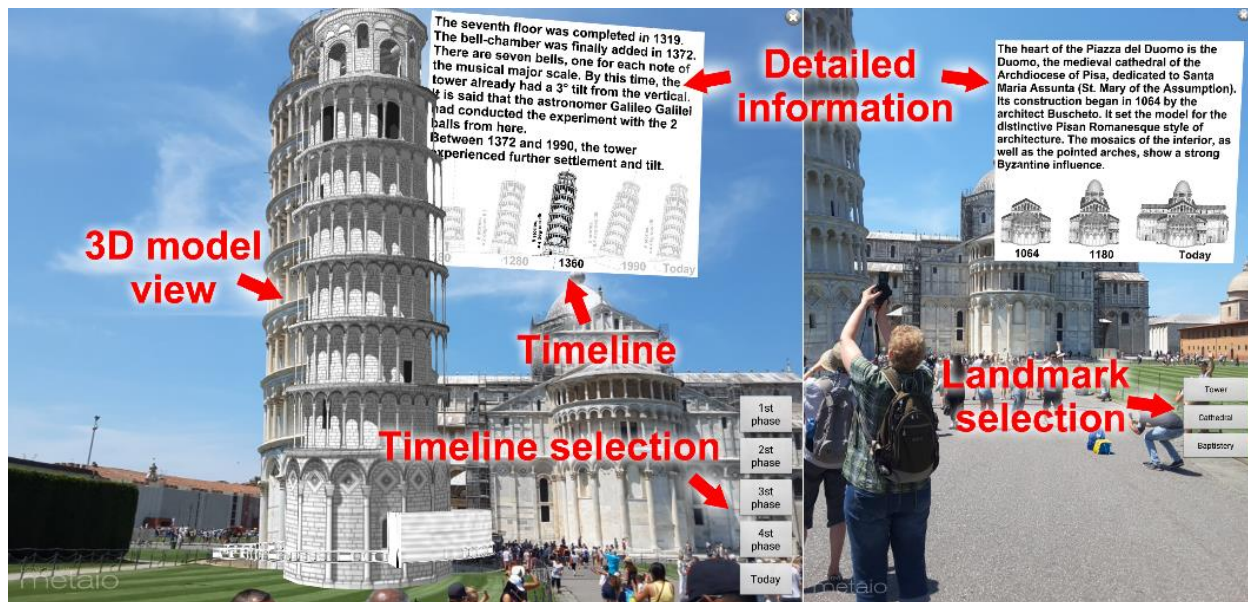


**eHeritage - Expanding the Research and

### 3 eHERITAGE’s members finished the external stages at for the first year of the project

The 3 researchers / associate professors from University Transilvania of Brasov (Mihai Duguleana, Cristian Postelnicu and Florin Garbacia) have returned from Scuola Superiore Sant’Anna from Pisa, Italy, having an enriched work experience. The stages were really focused on enhancing the information transfer from our SSSA partners towards the 3 members from UTBv. New equipment was tested and used. Technical and scientific knowledge was passed from the personnel of SSSA to the 3 short external stages participants. During these first external stages, both teams also managed to focus on the dissemination level, producing 3 articles:
