



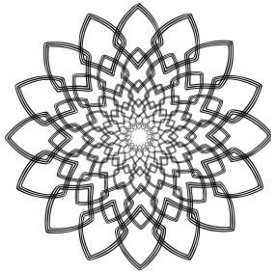

eHERITAGE enters in the second phase of the project

After the submission of deliverables to the EU, eHERITAGE members are focusing on strengthening their collaboration and cooperation on upcoming activities. We are preparing for the second exploratory meeting which will be hosted at the premises of UTBv. We are hoping to cooperate with our partners, SSSA and JSI on several research themes, including a study based on the EUROPEANA database, a research in intelligent virtual assistants which can offer customized suggestions in 3D applications and creating a protocol for multi-user reconstruction of 3D cities.

Our purpose for this second year is to increase the dissemination in peer-reviewed journals indexed in the Web of Knowledge database. We already have some work prepared for this endeavour, and we hope we will prepare more in the near future.

Besides the dissemination, 2 new activities started in the second year of the project:

- Task 4.1 Integration in EU centres of excellence [Lead: JSI, collaborate: UTBv, SSSA]
- Task 4.2 Preparation of research initiatives [Lead: JSI, collaborate: UTBv, SSSA]

We envision that we will propose a H2020 project together with our partners in the first part of 2017. We already spotted a call which may be suitable for this activity: H2020-SC6-CULT-COOP-2017 (UNDERSTANDING EUROPE - PROMOTING THE EUROPEAN PUBLIC AND CULTURAL SPACE). We hope to submit a proposal to this action in due time.
